PINOCHET

The family and friends of former dictator Augusto Pinochet Ugarte had come together, a cake had been delivered and the ambulance stood ready to drive him to the airport. Then, it was hoped, he would be able to fly to Chile. Although he had been under arrest in a north London hospital, his followers were sure that he would soon be celebrating more than his 83rd birthday. But Britain's highest court decided that Pinochet could face extraditions to Spain on charges of genocide, murder and torture committed during his years in power.

While Pinochet remained under police guard, still recovering from the back operation which had brought him to London, groups of Chilean exiles outside the hospital and Parliament popped champagne and cried with joy. Elena Sánchez, a University of Chile professor who was arrested imprisoned and tortured in 1974 said tearfully: "We never believed that this would happen." Amnesty International called it "the most important case in human rights law this century." This shows tyrants around the world that there are no safe places to escape from the consequences of their crimes.
